

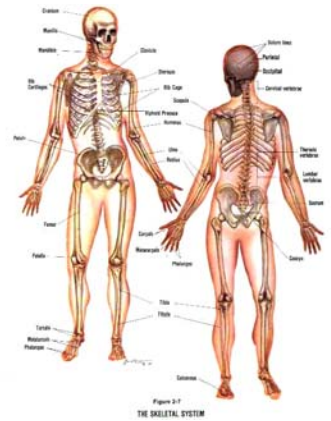

#### DIPLOMATE PROGRAM

The Diplomate of the ICA Council on Applied Chiropractic Sciences (**D.A.C.S.**) is a unique credentialled Board Certified program available to DCs focusing on research and clinical aspects of chiropractic detection, analysis, and case management of the VSC. The program involves a thorough post-graduate curriculum comprising up to 360 hours; more information is on the website.

#### ANNUAL CONFERENCE and EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

The Council holds educational seminars and conferences which offer 12-16 hours of continuing education credits. These programs provide special opportunities to sharpen clinical skills and expand knowledge and clinical resources relating to chiropractic clinical science and the Vertebral Subluxation Complex.
