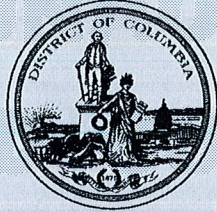

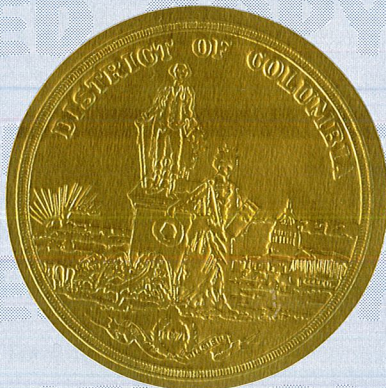

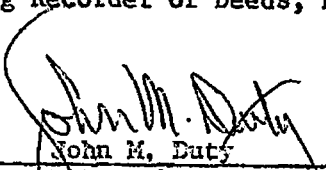

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

INTERNATIONAL CHIROPRACTORS ASSOCIATION, INC.

TO: The Recorder of Deeds, District of Columbia, Washington, D.C.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the District of Columbia Non-profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is International Chiropractors Association, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

The Corporation shall aim by research, publicity, combative and defensive legislation, lawful legal protection, cooperation, and in every legitimate and ethical way, to promote the advancement of the philosophy, Science and Art of Chiropractic and the professional welfare of members thereof, to the end that every locality shall have knowledge of Chiropractic and the unhampered right and opportunity of obtaining the services of Chiropractors of unquestionable standing and ability; this Corporation without reservation affirming the belief in the justice of the principle of allowing the sick to seek and obtain the services of practitioners of personal choice, of whatever calling, or school; and this Corporation to undertake everything that it can legally, lawfully and financially do to defend this principle; and, in general, to exercise such other powers which now are or hereafter may be conferred by the laws of the District of Columbia upon Corporations not-for-profit, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purposes of the Corporation, subject to such limitations as are or may be prescribed by law, and not in excess of those authorized by the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and all amendments thereto relative to organizations exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(6) thereof.

vided, however, that no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation affecting one or more of its purposes) and provided further that no member, director, or officer of the Corporation shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation.

FOURTH: MEMBERSHIP. The Constitution and Bylaws of the Corporation may provide for different classes of membership with differing rights and obligations.

FIFTH: BOARD OF DIRECTORS The affairs of the Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors which shall be elected as provided for in the Constitution and Bylaws of the Corporation. The initial Board of Directors is composed of seventeen (17) members and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve on the initial Board of Directors are as follows:

In the event of dissolution, all of the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall, after necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to such organizations as shall qualify under Section 501(c)(3) or Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.
